Cancellation: Clarification of STCW Endorsements Required for Able Seaman

MSIB 06-24 is cancelled. Able seamen manning vessels subject to the Standards of Training and Certification of Watchkeeping, as Amended (STCW), must hold an MMC with an endorsement as <u>either</u> Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch (RFPNW) <u>or</u> Able Seafarer – Deck (AS-D). Cancelling MSIB 06-24 better aligns the sea service requirements in Section 3534(j) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2024 (Public Law 118-31) with STCW and the Scale of Employment in Title 46 U.S.C. § 7312. This action allows mariners to fill a required able seaman billet on a vessel subject to STCW once they hold an appropriate national endorsement as able seaman and <u>either</u> RFPNW <u>or</u> AS-D.¹
