International Anti-Fouling System Certificates Notice of Proposed Rulemaking Published

The Coast Guard announced today *Federal Register* publication of a notice of proposed rulemaking that proposes to amend Coast Guard regulations for international certificates issued by recognized classification societies on its behalf.

Last year, Congress and the President enacted legislation to implement the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-Fouling Systems on Ships, 2001 (Convention). This notice of proposed rulemaking would add the International Anti-Fouling Systems (IAFS) certificate to the list of international certificates that a recognized classification society can be authorized to issue on the Coast Guard's behalf. By this action, the Coast Guard seeks to ensure U.S. ship owners and operators can conveniently obtain an IAFS certificate.
