**Description:** Vehicles transporting containers in and out of the port are weighed and compared

to Bill of Lading.

**Discussion**: Vehicles transporting containers are weighed upon entry and exit to the Port of

Lobito. The resulting weight is compared against the Bill of Lading and if a discrepancy occurs, the vehicle is physically searched by port security personnel.
