## **Best Practice: Security Throughout Supply Chain**

**Description:** The LocalFrio facility does not interface with ships but rather

transfers containers to the Libra Terminal for shipment. However, due to LocalFrio's close proximity to facilities that do interface with ships, the Designated Authority required LocalFrio to comply with the ISPS Code. LOCALFRIO is a model terminal for other terminals that do not have direct interaction with ships but are

located within the confines of the port.

**Discussion**: Cargo bound for the port is screed prior to entering the port grounds.

Potential Down-side: None.

**Conclusion:** Including facilities that interface with the port in the security measures

increases the overall security of the port prior to cargo actually entering

the port.

**Cost:** The initial cost of bringing these facilities into compliance can be

substantial.
