Description: Muara Conventional Terminal has designated areas in the facility as Emergency Assembly Points.

Discussion: In the event of a security or safety incident, all persons in the facility are required to report to a designated assembly point.

Potential Down-side: No potential down-side identified.

Conclusion: This approach provides for a quick accounting of personnel. If personnel are unaccounted for, quick action can be taken to verify their location and condition. Also, further instructions and updates can be passed to personnel.

Cost: The cost is minimal. Ensuring that signage is placed and that all persons on the facility are instructed as to where their assembly points are located.
