Proposed committee structure of the Conference and organization of work

1. After discussions at length on the basic concepts of a new tonnage measurement system the Conference decided the following:

The Conference agreed to instruct the Technical Committee to examine Proposal C contained in TM/CONF/6 and the Norwegian Proposal contained in TM/CONF/9/Add.1, with a view to selecting a parameter or parameters to be embodied in the proposed International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969. The Conference also agreed that the proposed Convention should not embody the concept of the dual tonnage as related to the tonnage mark.

The Conference requested the Technical Committee to report their conclusions on these matters by the morning of Tuesday, 3 June.
