National Merchant Marine Personnel Advisory Committee Meeting 8 – September 4-5, 2024

The Office of Merchant Mariner Credentialing is hosting the eighth meeting of the National Merchant Marine Personnel Advisory Committee (NMERPAC) September 4-5, 2024, in Washington, DC, at the Department of Homeland Security Headquarters. Pre-registration is mandatory for this meeting and is limited to the first 30 confirmed attendees.

Work groups for subcommittees listed in the Federal Register notice will meet on September 4, 2024. The committee will meet on September 5, 2024, to consider and vote on recommendations from the subcommittees that met the previous day, as well as subcommittees that met since the last NMERPAC meeting.

NMERPAC advises, consults with, and makes recommendations to the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security through the Commandant of the United States Coast Guard on matters relating to personnel in the United States Merchant Marine including the training, qualifications, certification, documentation, and fitness of mariners.
